PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE UNDER SEAL

Plaintiff Dope Ecommerce, LLC (“Plaintiff”) files this Motion requesting leave to file the following documents under seal: (1) Schedule A which will identify Defendants’ currently known aliases and Online Marketplaces and (2) Exhibit 2 to the Declaration file in connection with Plaintiff’s Memorandum of in Support of Plaintiff’s Motion for Entry of a Temporary Restraining Order, including a Temporary Injunction, a Temporary Asset Restraint, and Expedited Discovery (to be filed) which will contain documentary evidence of Defendants’ rampant infringement.

Plaintiff is requesting temporary *ex parte* relief based on an action for trademark infringement/counterfeiting and copyright infringement. Sealing this portion of the file is necessary to prevent the Defendants from learning of these proceedings prior to the execution of the temporary restraining order, negating the purpose of the *ex parte* proceeding.
